

FoG Tournament at the AttritiCon 2012 in Ulm

Location and Time: The tournament takes place at the Ruhetal in Ulm on the 19th and 20th of June (www.ruhetal.de).

Timetable:

We will play 4 rounds:

First round Saturday 9:30, 2. round Saturday evening at 18:30 (in between we will have several demo- and participation games). The 3. and 4. round will be on Sunday, starting at 9:00 and 13:30

Miniature Size: 15 mm

Rules: We use the official FOG-Rules incl. the errata and FAQ's (<http://www.fieldofglory.com/resources>)

Army Size: 800 points

1 MU = 1 inch

Table size 180 x 120 cm

Time: 3.5 hours, after the umpire has called the end of the round, the game will be stopped before the next JAP.

Drawing: Historical seeding in the first round, for all other rounds we use Swiss System

Rating system: we use the official 25-0 FoG rating system (incl. decimals).



Army lists

All lists in the 13 army books are allowed.

This tournament is a 2-lists-tournament.

Every player can have 2 different lists, coming from the same main list. These lists can differ in the number of BG's, Order of march, the

year, the allies, etc.

On each game, before the Pre-Battle-Initiative is rolled, each player selects the list he wants to use in this game.

No list is allowed to have more than 800 points.

Please sent the army lists in for checking until May 01st, 2012

The army lists have to include all BG's, the order of march, the year of the army and the territory options.
